Required Health Screening
2021-2022 School Year

All parents are asked to screen their child for viral symptoms prior to each religious education session by asking the following questions:

Does my child have:

- A fever greater than 100.4, without the use of symptom-relieving medication
- A cough that cannot be attributed to another health condition
- shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills that cannot be attributed to another health condition
- A sore throat that cannot be attributed to another health condition
- Muscle aches that cannot be attributed to another health condition
- A loss of taste or smell

If the answer is “YES” to any of the screening questions, students should remain at home and seek follow-up care with their primary care physician prior to returning to religious education.

Children are permitted to return to religious education classes when their health permits them to do so if all of the following apply:

- no known recent exposures to an individual who has tested positive for COVID,
- symptoms are believed to be the result of a common cold, allergies, non-COVID related virus,
- no fever is present of 100.4 or greater (without the use of symptom-reducing medications),
- no consecutive vomiting or diarrhea has occurred within the last 24 hours.

Please call the Director of Religious Education if your child has tested positive for the COVID virus or is currently quarantining due to a suspected case of COVID.
