_____ - This Gift of the Holy Spirit enables us “to think with the mind of Christ,” to appreciate divine things, to see the work of God in our lives, and to set our hearts on the what is truly important— God, virtue, prayer, and everlasting life.

_____ - With this Gift of the Holy Spirit, we are humble before God, realizing that all of our blessings come from Him and that we ought to worship Him.

_____ - The sacrament which gives the fullness of the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

_____ - A pure spirit and messenger of God. Each person has one appointed as a guardian.

_____ - The first Pope appointed by Jesus himself.

_____ - This person founded the Catholic Church.
