Speaking of Jumps ... how many of us recall the days of life before jets, air conditioning, color TV, cars with FM stereo systems, cell phones, computers, the internet, microwave ovens, and many more things that have impacted our socio/economic culture.

Such has not been the case in our spiritual development with the many devotional practices from the past that have been put aside in recent years. And that is to our loss. Now is the time to reclaim the strength of our hearts and souls with our sacramental and devotional exercises that strengthen our vocations and enhance our occupations. I applaud the fact that our CCD students are stopping in Church to say a "decade" of the rosary at the end of their classes each week and I encourage every family to say at least a decade each night before bedtime.
